JAPANESE BOOKBINDING 101

SUPPLY LIST For 6" x 9" books

KITS INCLUDE:

Pre-cut to size:

- 2 Peltex pieces for front & back covers
- 2 Hand-made papers for inside covers--choice of color
- 4 Heat 'n Bond Lite adhesive
- 20 Acid free paper pages
- Strips of heat fusible web—to cut as you go
- Cardstock template for positioning holes
- Awl
- Large tapestry needle
- Heavy-duty thread for inner binding
- Perle cotton or silk buttonhole thread for binding—choice of color
- Instructions and optional templates for cutting fabrics

STUDENTS' SUPPLY LIST:

- Scissors
- Rotary cutter
- Small mat and ruler (12" or larger)
- Pencil and eraser
- Thin Sharpie permanent marker, black
- 4 large binder clips
- Double-sided tape
- Fabric for front & back covers-- 2 pieces at least 7 ½" x 10 ½" (can match or be different!)
(TIP: Thinner fabrics such as cotton broadcloth are easier to wrap around the cover.)
- Fabric for title on cover -- solid color, 1 ¾" x 3 ½" or larger (optional)
- Fabrics for pages—keepsakes from quilts, weddings, or children's clothing; collections of hand-dyed/printed, hand or machine embroidered, or beaded fabrics; lace, handkerchiefs, UFOs, silk, batik; souvenirs from travels, ribbons and trophies; pattern covers, photos.
And other things I haven't even thought of!

CLASSROOM SUPPLIES (provided by instructor)

- Parchment paper to cover ironing mats
- Fabric glue
- Needle-nose pliers
- Strips of cardstock for binding spacers (optional)
- Freezer paper for tracing optional templates
